 - ❑ Gel pens (For Writer's Notebook, not required)

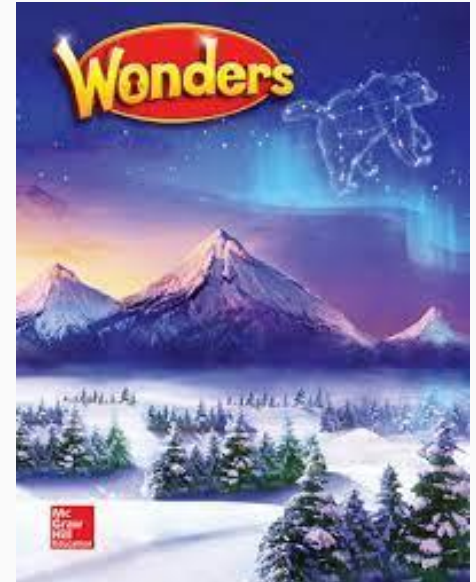


Wonders Curriculum

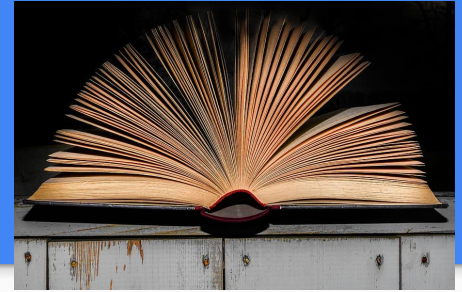
Students will be using the Wonders 2020 Reading program from McGraw Hill.

- This is a research-based program that is Common Core Aligned, uses authentic texts, and facilitates a community of learners through oral and written communication. Within the program, students will be tested on the following: Wonders relies heavily on a Close Reading Routine. Your child will be exposed to three texts; shared read, anchor text, and a paired passage.
- Students will be exposed to a comprehension skill and strategy, text genre, 8 vocabulary words, vocabulary skill, grammar skill, and 20 spelling words.

Assessments include: Warm and Cold Read Assessments, TDA (writing assignments), Grammar, and Spelling



Accelerated Reader (AR)



- ❑ Students will be required to independently read 8 points worth of AR books per quarter (Learning Support students and English Language Learners' goals will be modified as needed). This usually consists of 1-3 books depending on size, text complexity, and lexile or ATOS level.
- ❑ 5th grade has a generous classroom library from which students can check books in and out. Some children bring in books from home or rent from one of our local libraries.
- ❑ Once the book is completed, students take a quiz while in school. If a book is worth 4 points and they receive a 100 on the quiz, they receive all 4 points. If they get incorrect answers, points are deducted. If they take a quiz and fail, they cannot retake it. They must move on to a new book.
- ❑ Students cannot open the book while taking the quiz, but they can take notes while reading and those are allowed during the test.
- ❑ At the end of the quarter I tabulate how many points the student has earned out of the 8. Ex: $8/8=100\%$. $6/8=75\%$. This grade counts as one comprehension test grade.

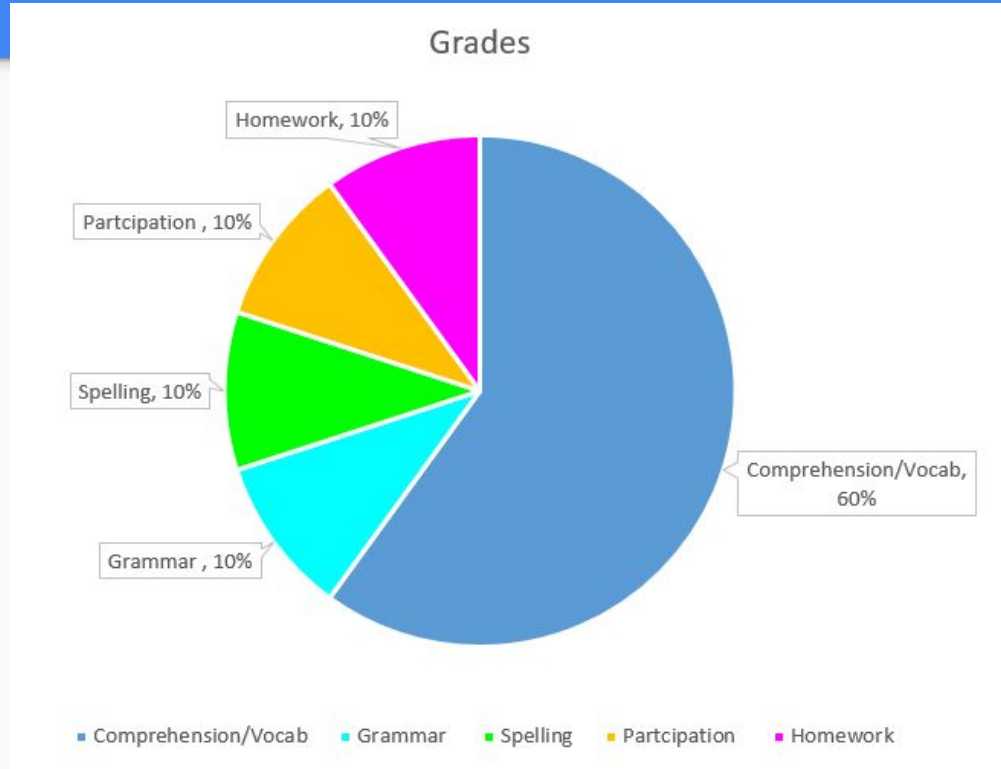
Grading

- ❑ Comprehension and Vocabulary: 60%
 - ❑ Warm Read Tests, Cold Read Tests, TDAs, AR Tests
- ❑ Grammar Tests: 10%
- ❑ Spelling Tests: 10%
- ❑ Homework: 10%
 - ❑ Mostly spelling and grammar
- ❑ Participation: 10%
