Curriculum

- Everyday Mathematics
- All lessons (in house and virtual) will follow the EM curriculum formations close as possible.
 - Interaction in small groups and one-on-one with other students will be limited.
 - Manipulatives will not be used as frequently, and will be sanitized after each use .
 - Most EM games will be played on the computer through ConnectEd.
 - All students will be provided a Login for the ConnectEd Student Center (this login is the same as the ELA Wonders login).
- Each student will be provided two Everyday Math Journals (volumes 1 and 2) and a packet of Home Links (homework).
- Homework will be checked when student gets to school (2 days worth) or virtually for Tier III.
- Grading will be the same as last year standards based a final percentage may be attached final decision not made
