HONORS PROGRAM SCHOLARSHIP

Lackawanna College Honors Program is designed for the Top Academically Ranked High School Seniors in every high school graduating class from 33 school districts across Northeastern and Central Pennsylvania. The Honors Program consists of **FULL TUITION SCHOLARSHIPS** to those top 10 ranked students in each school for up to four years. The students ranked from 11-20 will be offered 50% tuition scholarships for up to four years, with the opportunity to earn full scholarships based on financial need.

This program is the first of its kind in NEPA and is positioned to be a transformational opportunity for the both the students and for our region. The Honors Program will provide not just scholarships but also comprehensive educational experiences that will prepare graduates to emerge as leaders ready to change the face of their communities. These educational experiences include leadership opportunities, meaningful immersive service to and in our community, and experiential challenging curricula. Details:

- The amount of the award is based upon the student's final class rank. Students who finish in the top ten of their graduating class will be guaranteed a full-tuition scholarship after any applicable financial aid. Students who finish with a class rank of 11-20 will be guaranteed a half-tuition scholarship after any applicable financial aid.
- The scholarship is good for up to four years of consecutive enrollment toward the degree of the student's choice.
- The student must complete a FAFSA prior to enrollment and each year after.
- The student must enroll full time (minimum 12 credits) in a Lackawanna College program in the Fall 2020 semester following high school graduation to receive this scholarship.
- The student must maintain a 3.25 GPA and be enrolled in a minimum of 12 credits/semester at all times to remain eligible for the scholarship
- This award covers tuition costs only. Fees, books, room and board and other costs are the responsibility of the student. The College will not make direct cash payments to the scholarship recipients nor create a credit balance on the student's account.
- Students enrolling in the Associate of Science in Nursing program are not eligible.
