FIRST THREE DAYS OF SCHOOL

•For the first 3 days of school in addition to their student passport (lanyard), all parents are asked to send their child to school wearing a name tag that contains their name, child's teacher, grade and transportation home (car rider, bus number and name of stop). You can use a sticker / mailing label or even pin an index card to their shirt. We want to make sure all of our information matches.





Daily Schedule

- Doors open <u>9:00 AM the first week of school.</u>(Early supervision 9:00 AM 9:10 AM)
- Students may enter classrooms <u>9:10 AM 9:25 AM</u>
- All students must be in school by <u>9:30 AM</u>.
- Morning announcements start by 9:35 AM.
- The District runs a Six Day Cycle Schedule. Wednesday, September 6th is Day 1. TH 9/7/23 = Day 2, F 9/8/23 = Day 3, M 9/11/23 = Day 4, T 9/12/23 = Day 5, W 9/13/23 = Day 6, TH 9/14/23 = Day 1. Non school days are skipped.
- The Cycle Days really only determine which Special is on which day.
- Car line dismissal will begin at <u>3:00 PM</u> for the first week or so. Once the students and parents are used to the routine, dismissal will begin at <u>3:10 PM</u>.







Morning Arrival

- Please remain in your vehicle. Pull all the way up along the sidewalk in front of the school beginning at 9:00 AM. There will be staff members there to assist your child out of the car if they need assistance. You should practice having your child buckle and unbuckle their seatbelt. Have everything ready to go; backpacks, good-byes, etc.
- We do not start to get students out of the cars until 9:10 AM (9:00AM first week). There is no need to arrive at the school earlier than that time.
- Please be mindful of little, young impressionable ears. We ask that you watch your language, and music content while on school property.
- We kindly ask for cooperation, patience and grace as everyone learns the procedure.

Car Pick Up Dismissal

- Please remain in your vehicle. There are two car lines. Pull all the way up. Do not pull around other cars or drive through the middle of the lanes to get out of the line as our staff members are crossing little ones to the second car line.
- A staff member will direct you when you can move forward / leave the line.
- We do not start to move the line until 3:05 PM (3:10 PM)
- Your car tag must be hanging and visible for our staff to check you in.
- A staff member will bring your child to your car, open the door and assist them getting in.
- Have your child practice buckling their own seat belt. We do not buckle the children.
- We kindly ask for cooperation, patience and grace as everyone learns the procedure.



Pick Up Patrol (PUP) and The Car Line / Bus Dismissal

- All parents must use PUP. If you do not have an email address or access to the internet, we will make accommodations for you.
- This is not an app. You have to save it to your home-screen.
- PUP is used for late arrival, early dismissal, daily absences, and dismissal plan changes.
- If your child is a car rider you must have a car tag displayed during pick up. You do not need it for drop off.

Default plans will be locked on 9-5-23. If you need to change your child's default plan once the year starts, you will need to email Mary or call the office.

- Walkers, parents you must bring a photo id.
- Please DO NOT arrive to the school prior to 9:00 AM or 3:05 PM. The car line does not begin to move until 9:00 AM / (3:05) 3:10 PM. Arriving early just causes a traffic jam. We can empty our car lines in 12-15 minutes once we start to move them.
- Buses depart beginning at approximately 3:30 PM.
- We apologize in advance, but everything runs late the first week.







Walker Dismissal

- Please wait on the sidewalk outside of the walker door.
- A staff member will open the door to check you in and tap out your child.
- We do not start dismiss walkers until 3:05 / 3:10
- Please DO NOT "drive" and park your car in the staff lot bypassing the car line to pick your child up as a walker. You are asked to park at the library and walk over if this is your preferred method of dismissal.
- We kindly ask for cooperation, patience and grace as everyone learns the procedure.





FREE Breakfast and Lunch

- All students will receive a FREE breakfast and lunch daily.
- If your child will be packing a lunch (snack), please be mindful of classmates with food allergies.
- Breakfast is eaten in the classroom
- Lunch will be eaten in the cafeteria.
- All students may bring a water bottle. We have 2 filling stations.
- We ask that you refrain from sending in soda and fast food.





FREE Children's Produce Market

- All families regardless of income are eligible.
- The market is held once per month. It is on the third Tuesday, after school from 4:00 5:00 in the cafeteria.
- It will be a self shop format. Please bring your own shopping bags!
- Everyone is welcome. There are no income requirements.





Attendance & Truancy

Attendance

- Please do your best to have your child attend school every day.
- In the event of illness (vomiting, fever), please keep them home.
- Up to 10 parent "notes" are acceptable to excuse an absence. Any absence after 10 days must have a doctor's note.
- Absences must be entered with a reason in PUP. This will serve as your "parent note."
- Work for absent students can be obtained by contacting your child's teacher.

Truancy

- Students are considered truant after 3 unexcused absences.
- Students are considered habitually truant after 10 absences.
- 3 day and 10 day letters, SAIP Meetings (w/ STARS Lackawanna County representative)
- Mr. Lacomis is our truancy monitor.







Car Tag Pick Up / Uniform Pick Up

Car Tags

- If you plan on picking your child up on the first day of school, you will need to pick up your car tag on Tuesday, September 5th between 1:00 PM & 3:30 PM.
- Students taking the bus on the first day will not need their tag.
- Students riding the bus will have their car tags sent home on the first day. Please keep them in your car.
- If you are unable to pick up your car tag, you can bring your photo id on the first day..

Uniform Pick Up

- If you are in need of gently used uniforms, you can contact our school nurse for assistance or stop by Moosic Presbyterian Church Clothing Closet on Saturdays from 10:00 – 12:00.
- ** We take gently used / clean uniform donations throughout the year. Parents can request uniforms at any time.





Dress Code / Student Passport (Lanyard & ID)

Students must wear any solid navy, red or white shirt. The logo no longer needs to be embroidered.

Any Riverside Spirt Wear shirt is acceptable

Pants / shorts must be khaki or navy. (Girls skorts, skirts, jumpers, dresses, shorts)

On PE day, students may wear navy, red, white, grey gym shorts, wind pants or sweat pants.

For girls, any type of tights are acceptable.

Sneakers are preferred or any closed toe shoes. Color does not matter.

It is suggested all students keep an emergency change of clothes in their backpack.

Many organizations sell spirit-wear throughout the year. (Remind app. Mr. Brennan)

Students will be given their student passport on the first day of school. This will contain their id number, PBIS QR code, and dismissal information. They must wear this to school every day!







School Nurse / Medical Information

Mrs. Saunders is our school nurse.

Please communicate specific medical concerns and needs to her.

Complete emergency cards and other requested information.

Medication can not be given without an order from the doctor.

Do not send medication to school with your child. It must be brought in by a parent.

We do make accommodations as necessary for students with specific medical needs.
