





Mrs. Garland taught in the Social Studies Department for 34 successful years at Riverside High School. She has enlightened many students throughout her career.

Building the Future...How Does it Look?

To build the future, you have to look at the present, and that is exactly what the Class of 2003 at Riverside did in their senior year.

The high school was subject to a massive reconstruction project, and we were stuck right in the middle of it. Exposed pipes, open ceilings, and hanging wires greeted us inside the front door of our first day of our senior year. Eyes were focused upwards as the skeleton of a drop-ceiling gave way to a dreary-gray structural steel roof.

The sounds of banging hammers, sauderling guns, and walls crashing became second nature to us by October. The new gym and science rooms (which coincidentally were supposed to be done by Christmas, and later March) slowly took place outside in the courtyard behind the main office. Classrooms were ripped to their bare necessities, and the windows were removed in the cold winter months.
